Prince George's County Leaders Endorse Anthony Brown for Congress

LARGO, Md. -- Citing his commitment to public service and track record of fighting for Maryland families, several Prince George's County leaders are uniting behind Anthony G. Brown's bid for Congress.

Maryland Senators Joanne C. Benson (District 24) and Ulysses Currie (District 25); Delegates Carolyn J.B. Howard and Michael L. Vaughn (both District 24); Prince George's County Council Chairman Derrick Leon Davis (District 6) and County Councilwoman Karen R. Toles (District 7); and Bladensburg Mayor Walter James have all endorsed Brown for Congress.

"I've worked with Anthony for years on behalf of the residents of Prince George's County and I'm proud to endorse my teammate and friend Anthony Brown for Congress," said Chairman Davis. "The 4th District is well positioned for economic growth, but Anthony's leadership will be critical to ensuring we bring a regional hospital to Largo and the FBI Headquarters to Prince George's County."

"I'm proud and humbled to receive the endorsements of Prince George's local leaders," said former Lt. Governor Anthony Brown. "They have been on the frontlines serving our community and understand how critical this election is. In addition to today's local endorsements, Brown received the endorsement of [UNITE HERE](#), an international labor union that represents 15,000 workers in Maryland and D.C. area hotels, casinos, cafeterias, and airports.

Brown is running a strong, grassroots campaign to represent the people of Prince George's and Anne Arundel Counties in Congress. He has consistently led in every poll. The campaign has called over 14,000 residents and knocked on over 6,000 doors, and is talking with tens of thousands of voters in the district about Anthony's work to carry on President Obama's agenda by increasing local economic development, expanding early childhood education, passing common-sense gun regulations, and protecting Social Security and Medicare.
