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Anthony Brown Condemns Donald Trump's Refusal to Disavow KKK

LARGO, Md. – Responding to recent [reports](#) that Republican Presidential candidate Donald Trump has refused to disavow support from the Ku Klux Klan (KKK), Anthony Brown, a leading Democratic candidate for Congress in Maryland's 4th District, released the following statement:

"It is incredibly irresponsible and dangerous for Donald Trump to refuse to condemn this extreme white supremacist group with a history of violence," said former Lt. Governor Anthony Brown. "Every step of the way, Mr. Trump continues to prove that he is unequivocally unfit to be President of the United States. I call on Mr. Trump to publicly reject the KKK and all hate groups that preach racial supremacy and discrimination. We must say no to the politics of destruction and division once and for all."

"America faces many great challenges today," continued Brown. "There's rampant gun violence destroying our communities, racial violence and a flawed criminal justice system, where too many of our country's African-American men are missing from their families. From Ferguson to Baltimore, the pattern has been undeniable."

Now more than ever, we need strong leaders who will move our country forward and offer real solutions to serious and systemic challenges that we simply cannot wait to fix and heal," continued Brown.
