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**UPDATED: Anthony Brown for Congress Racks Up Endorsements
from Notable Maryland Leaders**

Brown Earns Endorsement of former Senator Philip C. Jimeno of Anne Arundel County

LARGO, Md. -- Anthony Brown, a leading Democratic candidate for Maryland's 4th Congressional District and former Lt. Governor, announces a slew of endorsements from notable Maryland leaders:

Former Maryland Senator Philip C. Jimeno of Anne Arundel County (District 31), Maryland Senators Douglas J.J. Peters (Prince George's, District 23) and Ed DeGrange (Anne Arundel District 32); Delegate Joseph Vallario (District 23B), Chair of the House Judiciary Committee; former Senator Gloria G. Lawlah (District 26); former Delegates Aisha Braveboy and Melony Griffith (District 25); former Councilman Floyd E. Wilson, Jr., (District 5), the first African-American to serve on the Prince George's County Council; and former Bladensburg Councilwoman Trina Brown (Ward 1) have all endorsed Brown's bid for Congress.

"Anthony Brown has been fighting for Prince George's County for years and he has a strong record of championing the interests of working families and small, women and minority-owned businesses," said former Delegate Braveboy.

"Anthony Brown understands the needs of Anne Arundel County, and in Congress he'll go to bat for working families to make college more affordable and bring new jobs to the region," said Senator DeGrange.

They join Senate President Mike Miller, Jr., who also endorsed Brown this week, calling him an "effective leader and legislator for the people of Maryland."

"Republicans are desperate to turn back the clock on President Obama's progress. Now more than ever, we need to keep fighting for Maryland's hardworking families and an economy that works for everyone," said Brown. "I will go to Congress to reform our criminal justice system, expand early childhood education and boost economic development in the region."

Brown has been endorsed by Maryland Senators Joanne C. Benson (District 24) and Ulysses Currie (District 25); Delegates Carolyn J.B. Howard and Michael L. Vaughn (both District 24); Prince George's County Council Chairman Derrick Leon Davis (District 6) and County Councilwoman Karen R. Toles (District 7); and Bladensburg Mayor Walter James.

He was also endorsed by UNITE HERE, an international labor union that represents 15,000 workers in Maryland and D.C. area hotels, casinos, cafeterias, and airports.

Brown is running a strong, grassroots campaign to represent the people of Prince George's and Anne Arundel Counties in Congress. Brown has consistently led in every poll. The campaign has talked to tens of thousands of voters in the district about Brown's work to carry on President Obama's agenda by increasing local economic development, expanding early childhood education, making higher education more affordable, and protecting Obamacare, Social Security and Medicare.
